Suggested sources for the letters are one from the teacher's principal, one from a peer, and one from a student or student family member. Please be sure to use the nominee's last name as part of the file name or submit printed copies with your physical application. Accepted file types include: .pdf, .doc, .docx only. Please note Mac files must be converted to Microsoft or Adobe file types.

**Part 3: Statement of Educational Philosophy**– A narrative statement written by the nominee outlining their educational philosophy. This may highlight the following:

1. Values, beliefs, and goals as an educator
2. Teaching methods applied in the classroom
3. Methods of assessing students' learning and their own teaching success
4. How they've grown as an educator and what influences them

Response should be limited to two pages typed and must include the nominee's last name as part of the file name and listed in the header of the document. Accepted file types include: .pdf, .doc, .docx only. Please note Mac files must be converted to Microsoft or Adobe file types.

**Part 4: Portfolio/Work Samples** - A portfolio of the teacher's work and accomplishments should be submitted with this application. Portfolio pieces could include: student notes, interesting projects, unique assignments, or examples of classroom work. A compelling portfolio will convey how the nominee connects with students, the community, and peers. Please be sure to use the nominee's last name as part of the file name and in the header of each page. Accepted file types include: .pdf, .jpg, .doc, .docx, .mp3, .wav, .flv, .mov, .avi, .wmv, .swf and .mht.
